# When do I need to have proof of vaccination?



- Starting Sept 22, 2021 you will have to provide the receipt of your second vaccination with ID confirming your name matches the name on your second dose.



- Your second dose must be 14 days before the date you are trying to access the venue.



- After Oct 22, 2021 in addition to proof of identity a patron may present a paper (PDF) or digital version (QR) to gain access to designated settings.

# What documents can I use as proof of vaccination?

- Downloaded vaccination receipt ( digital or printed paper copy) you can get access through Ontario's provincial booking portal <https://covid19.ontariohealth.ca/> or by calling 1-833-943-3900

- An Ontario vaccination receipt from a vaccine clinic or Ontario Ministry of Health when you received your dose.
- A vaccination receipt signed by an Indigenous Health Provider.
- A vaccination receipt from another jurisdiction that shows the holder is fully vaccinated against COVID-19.

Please note, that either the MINISTRY of HEALTH receipt and the WATERMARK receipt are totally valid.

# If you do not have a health card...

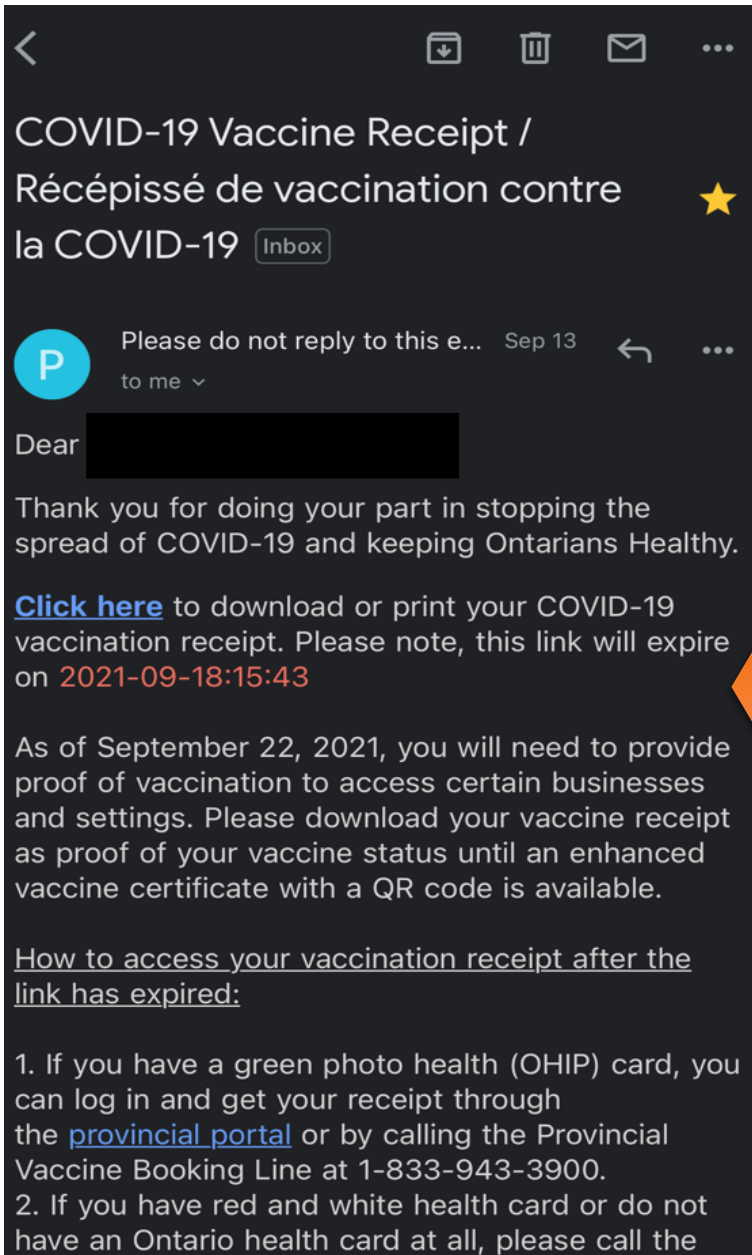

# If you got one or more of your doses outside of Ontario.

- If you received one or more doses of the COVID-19 vaccine out of province, [contact your local public health unit](#) to record your information and receive proper documentation.
- Proof of vaccination may also include a vaccination receipt from another jurisdiction that shows the holder is fully vaccinated against COVID-19.

## Submit Your COVID-19 Immunization Records for Out of Ontario Vaccination

### Who Does This Apply To

- If you live in city of Toronto and received one dose of a two-dose vaccine **outside Ontario**, your first dose needs to be documented before you can book your second dose.
- You can document individual COVID-19 vaccines or a full series through this online portal.
- Some people vaccinated in Ontario received vaccine from what is referred to as **non-Ontario stock**. Generally these doses were delivered at institutions such as correctional facilities, military sites or embassies. People who received one or two doses of vaccine from the non-Ontario stock may also document them through this online portal.

### What Do I Need To Complete This Process

- You will be required to submit **proof of vaccination**. If you do not have proof of vaccination, please contact the health care provider who gave you the COVID-19 vaccine(s) to receive a copy of your vaccination record.
- You will also be required to provide a **phone number and/or email address** where we can reach you to inform you that your records have been documented in the Provincial system. Also, to notify you (if eligible) to proceed to book your second dose appointment through the Provincial COVID Vaccine Booking System.

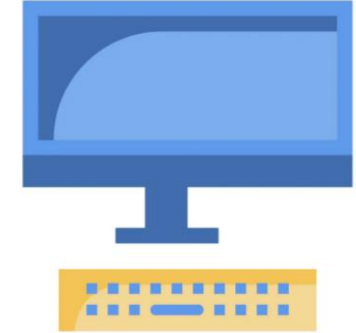

# What if they don't have a computer?



Ontario will develop and provide additional tools to improve user experience, efficiency and business supports in the coming weeks, including establishing alternative tools for people with no email, health card or ID.

# What can I show as proof of identity?

The list of ID documents is not exclusive, it just needs to be something that shows **NAME AND DATE OF BIRTH** but does not need to have a photo – and can be internationally issued.

- A birth certificate.
- Passport.
- Drivers license.
- Government issued ID- card including health card (OHIP).
- An Indian Status Card or Indigenous Membership Card.
- Permanent Resident Card.
- Citizenship card.



# What to do in case I got a denied access?

We encourage you to keep a screenshot of the provincial site with the requirements where explains very clearly stating that not only the watermark receipt version is valid required, and remember that ID requirements are not an exclusive list.

# Where will I be required to show proof of vaccination?



- Restaurants and bars (excluding outdoor patios, as well as delivery and takeout);
- Nightclubs (including outdoor areas of the establishment);
- Meeting and event spaces, such as banquet halls and conference/convention centres;
- Facilities used for sports and fitness activities and personal fitness training, such as gyms, fitness and recreational facilities with the exception of youth recreational sport;
- Sporting events;
- Casinos, bingo halls and gaming establishments;
- Concerts, music festivals, theatres and cinemas;
- Strip clubs, bathhouses and sex clubs;
- Racing venues (e.g., horse racing).

# Will people with medical exemptions be allowed to access settings requiring proof of vaccination?

- The only exemptions permitted to enter these settings are for unvaccinated people with medical exemptions and people under 12 years old. Individuals who cannot receive the vaccine due to medical exemptions will be permitted with a doctor's note until the medical exemption can be integrated as part of a digital vaccine certificate.



- Individuals aged 11 and under will be eligible to access these settings. If they are accompanied by an adult, the adult must be vaccinated.

# Proof of vaccination will not be required for:



- Essential purposes (e.g. groceries, hygiene products, healthcare).



- Retail purchases.
- Take out – Pick –Up



- Entering places of worship.
- Accessing an establishment solely to use a washroom.

# “Fully vaccinated” means:



- The full series of a COVID-19 vaccine authorized by Health Canada or any combination of such vaccines (i.e. 2 doses in Canada).
- One or two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine not authorized by Health Canada, followed by one dose of a COVID-19 mRNA vaccine authorized by Health Canada.
- Three doses of a COVID-19 vaccine not authorized by Health Canada.
- They received their final dose of the COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days before providing the proof of being vaccinated.

# How will QR codes work?



- A QR is the square barcode you can find in many products, posters.
- After Oct 22, 2021 in addition to proof of identity a patron may present a paper or digital version of the PDF receipt (vaccine certificate with QR code to gain access to designated settings).
- You will be able to re-download your proof of vaccination with a QR Code.

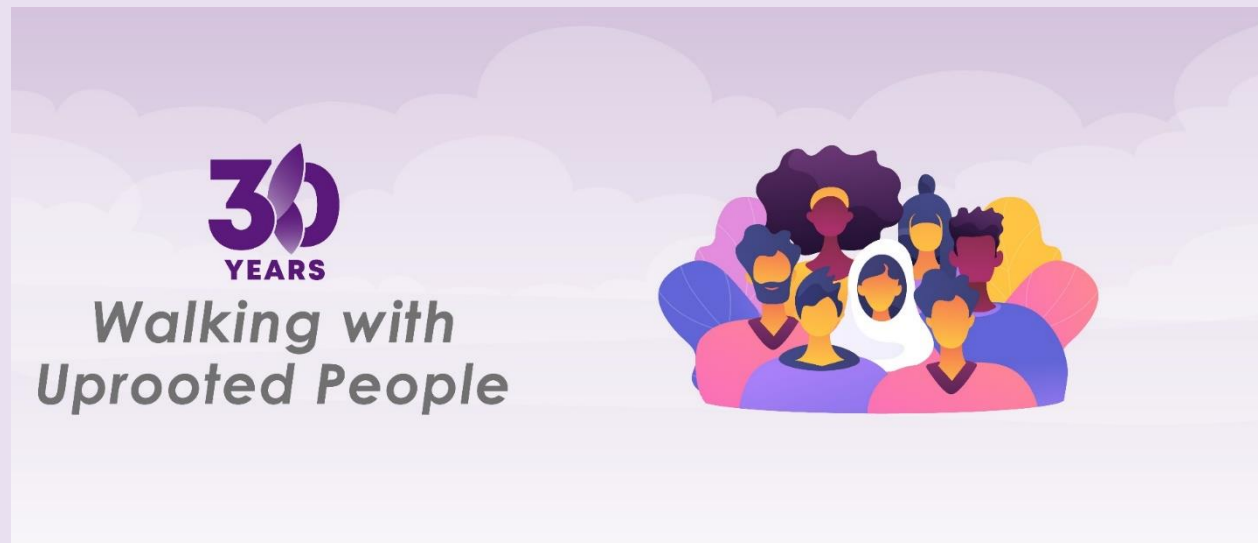
